Ministry of the Interior resolved **265 requests** for international protection in 2015

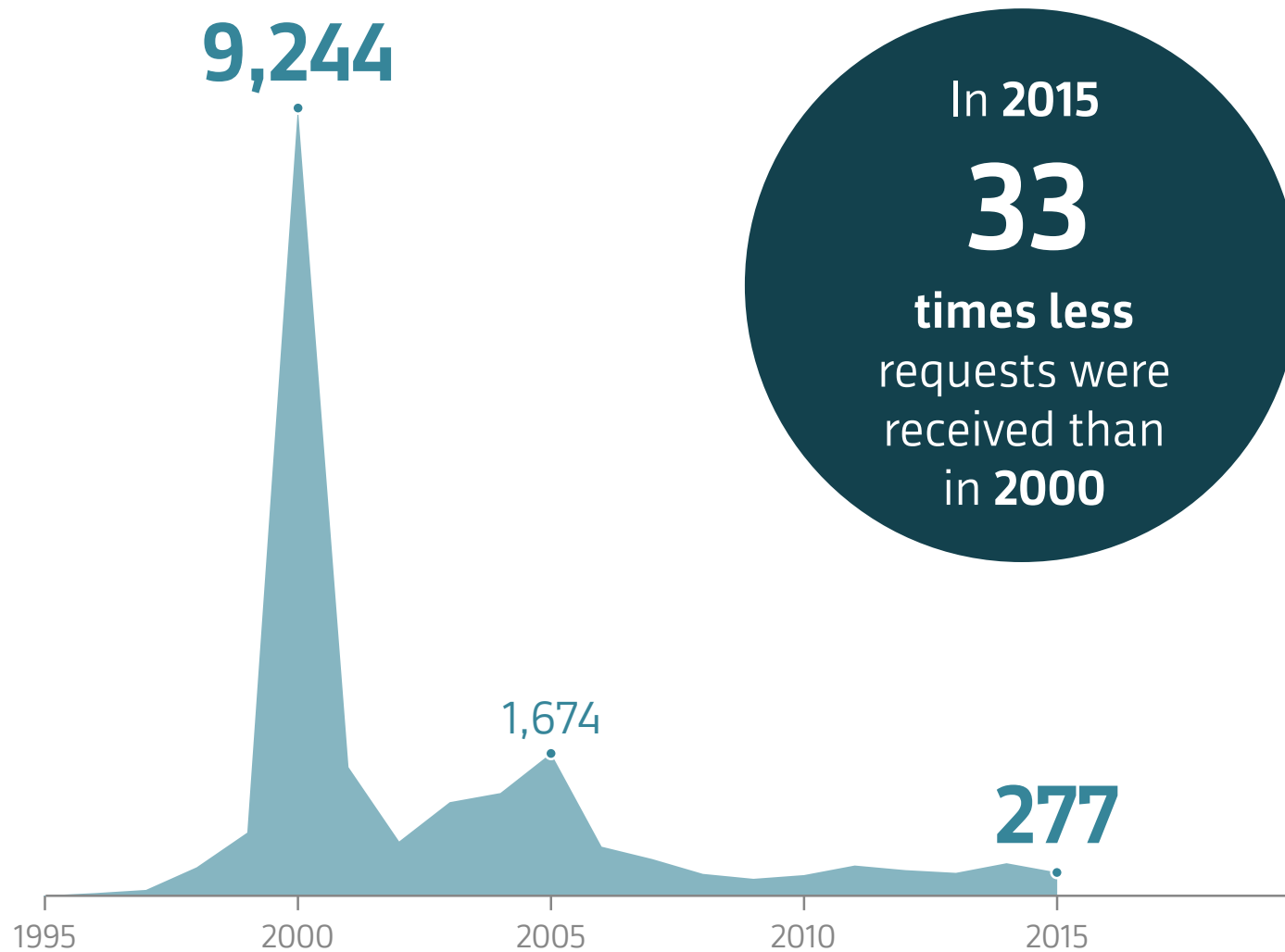
45

protection



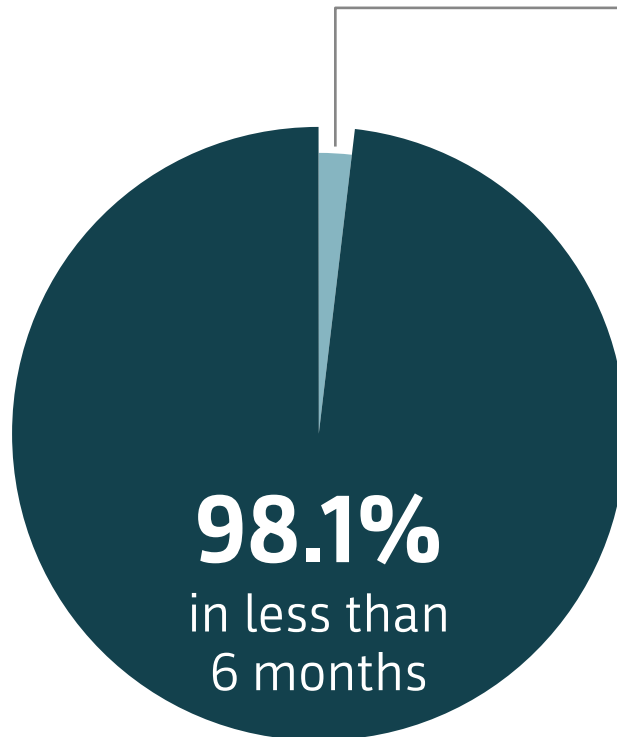
17% of requests

Almost **all request procedures** were resolved in **less than** required **6 months**



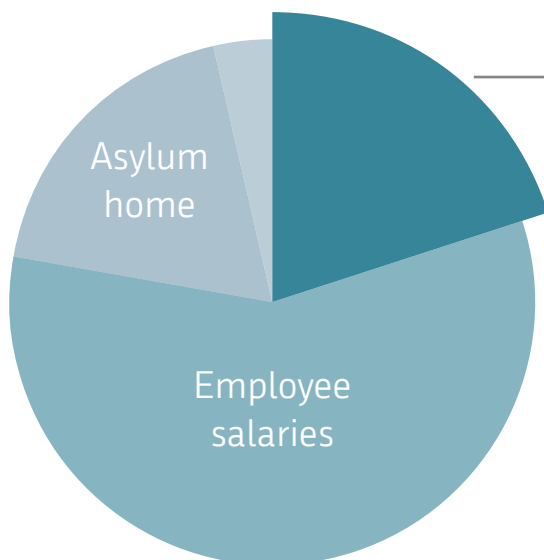
Most common reason

19% of EU Funds

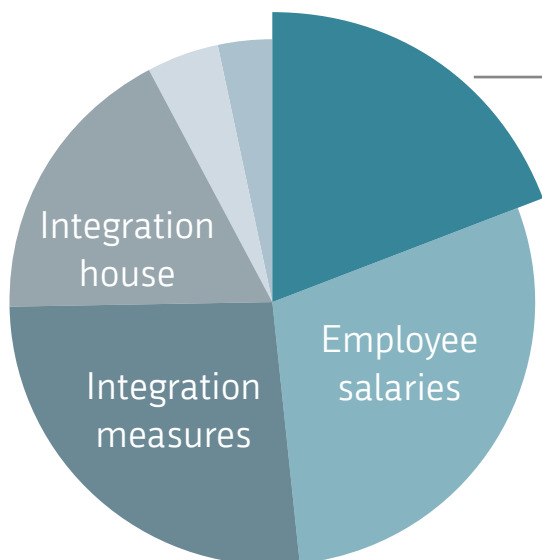
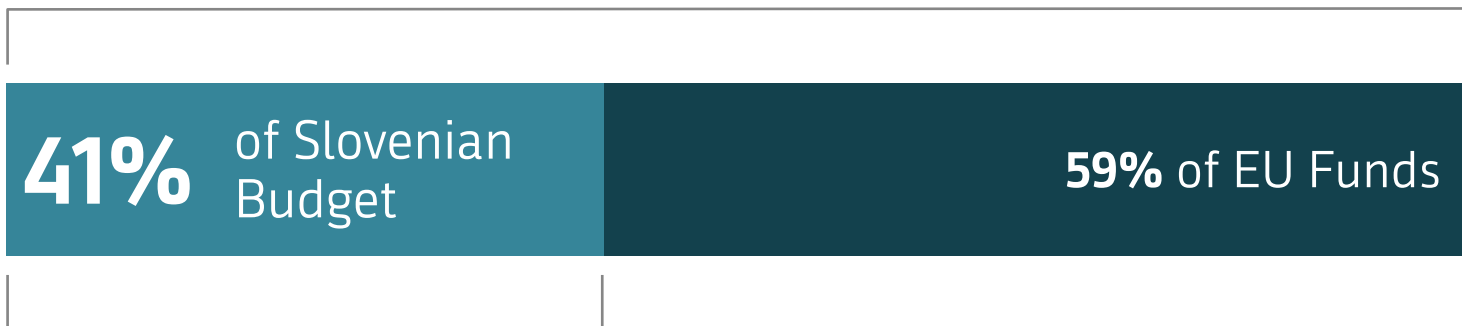


20% of budget funds for treatment of applicants

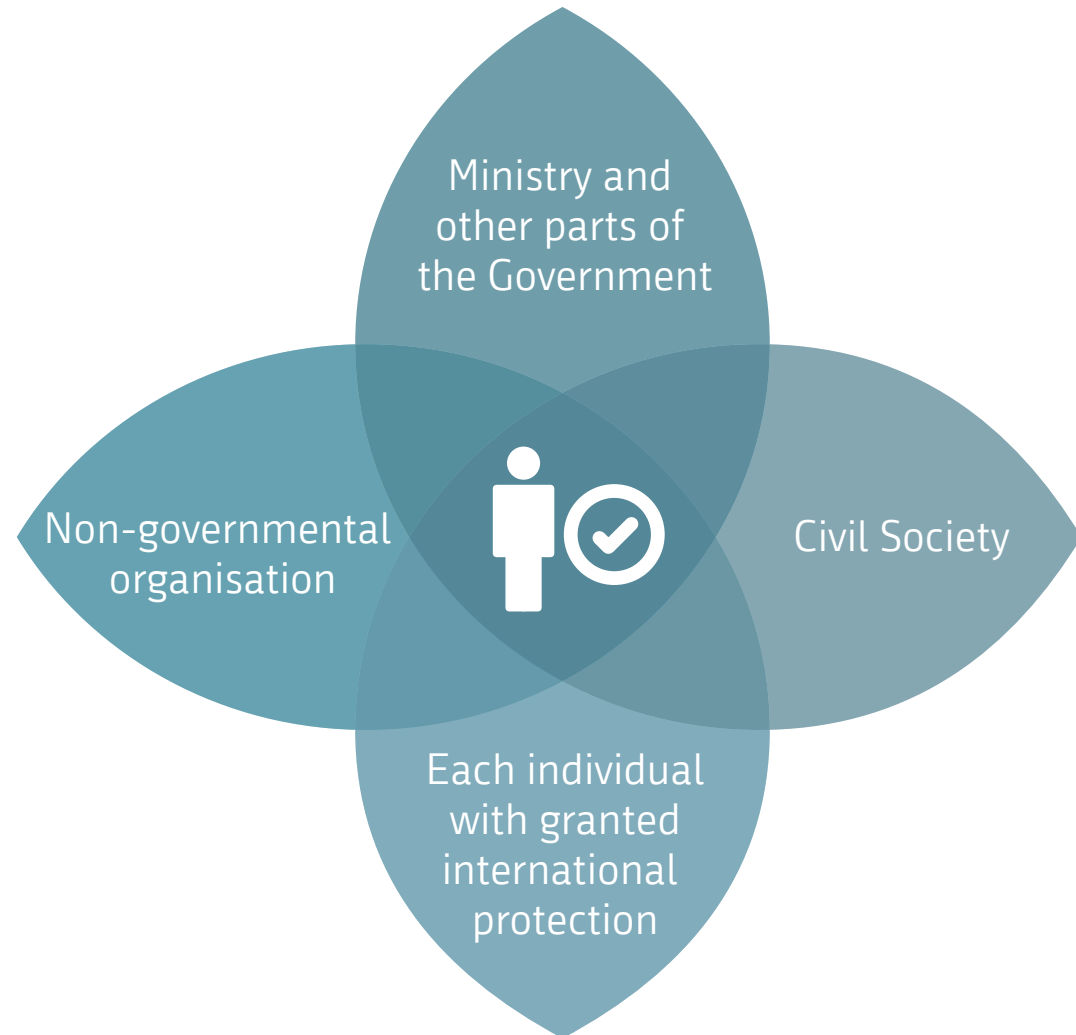
