Audited period: 1 January 2008 to 31 December 2015



**The deadline** for the adoption of a spatial plan **expired** in the middle of **November 2009** 




**82** municipalities had no spatial plan adopted, some **not even** started with its preparation by the end of 2015


#### Reasons

**No incentives** for adoption respectively **no sanctions** in case of not adopting municipal spatial plans

Possibility of **modifying** and supplementing **old spatial regulations** 



## **Duration** of the municipal spatial plan adoption procedure



Spatial plan preparation procedure was not subject to review



#### 1,315 days

on average lasts the procedure from drawing up a draft to adopting a plan, which is more than

3 years and 7 months



Main reasons for a lengthy procedure


Bodies participating in the spatial plan adoption procedures do not issue opinions within legal deadlines

**No mechanism for** settling disagreements


No comprehensive consideration of interests
