

The Court of Audit carried out an audit of the cultural heritage protection in the field of sports already in 2017 and established that the Government and the Ministry of Education, Science and Sport were inefficient.



The Ministry of Education, Science and Sport has not make the decisions as regards:



due to redecoration of premises and setting up new depository. The access to the museum items is possible only by prior arrangement.



the new location of the museum

the staffing and the number of employees in the museum



the organisational form of the museum



the method of financing the operation of the museum

OPINION OF THE COURT OF AUDIT

The Ministry of Education, Science and Sport was inefficient in the field of sports heritage protection.

CORRECTIVE MEASURES

The Ministry must prepare a plan of activities and provide constant supervision of the implementation thereof in order to implement the measures proposed in the Resolution on the National Programme of Sport of the Republic of Slovenia 2014-2023 (ReNPŠ14-23), namely:



to build up and complete the museum's **collection** pertaining to different sporting disciplines and presentation thereof



to set up an efficient organisational structure of the museum



to establish a communicative national museum institution attractive to visitors, sponsors and donors





The Ministry of Education, Science and Sport should:

RECOMMENDATIOS



set up an efficient museum institution in terms of staffing and organisational structure on the appropriate location enabling the arrangement of a permanent exhibition presenting the history of

Slovenian sport, the storage of items in line with the museum standards and the development of all necessary museum activities aimed at various public



determine the method of financing of the national museum institution which is to be organised in accordance with the Resolution on the National Programme of Sport of the Republic of Slovenia 2014-2023 (ReNPŠ14-23)
