





By failing to properly manage St Jernej Canal, the State provided the owners of the vessels, among them also legal persons, a common benefit due to free mooring in the amount of:

- € 807,232 calculation for municipal mooring
- **€ 2,533,425** calculation for commercial mooring




The Municipality and public company Environment Piran conclude a concession contract for management of the port in St Jernej Canal.






OPINION OF THE COURT OF AUDIT
