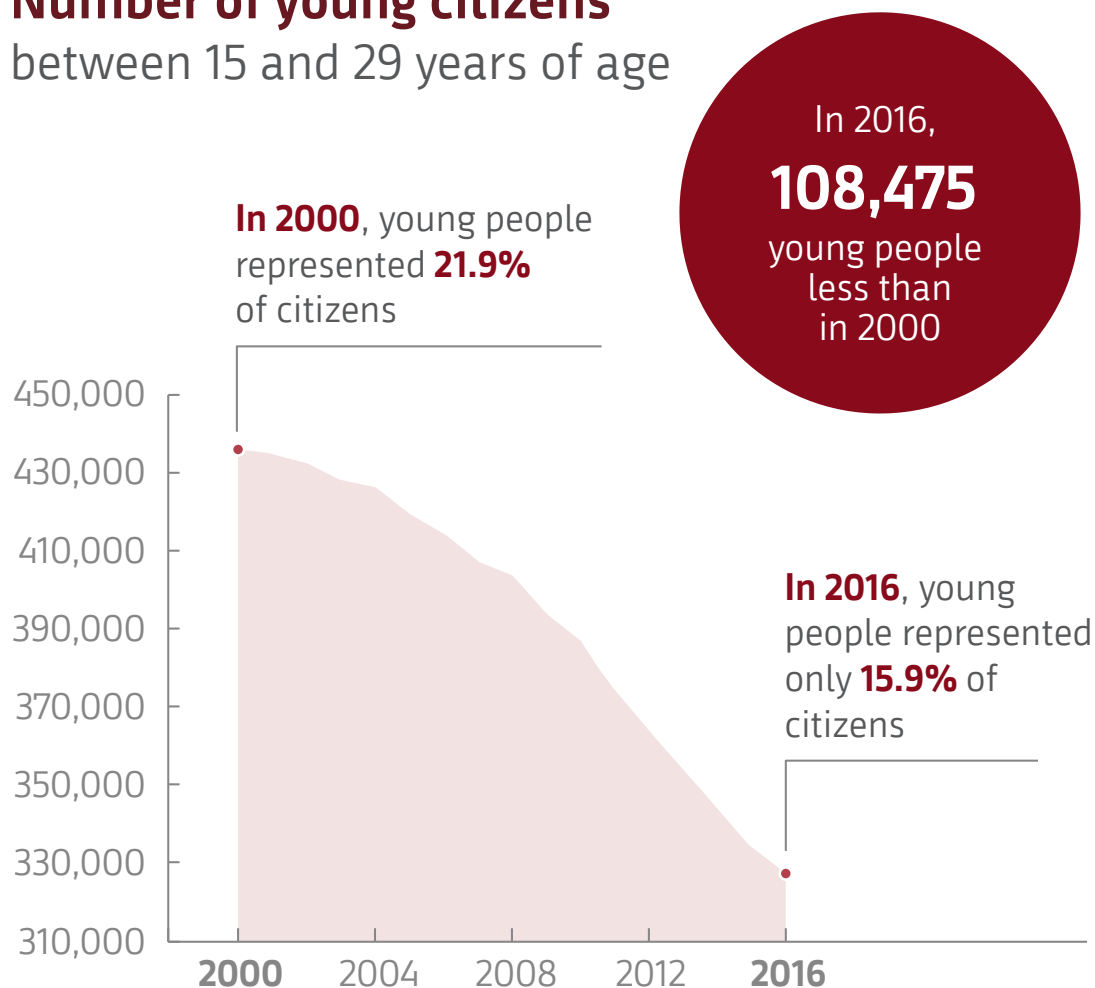
## Efficiency of youth policy

Audited period: 1 January 2014 to 31 December 2015

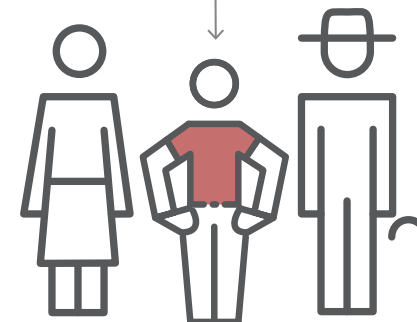


## Number of young citizens between 15 and 29 years of age



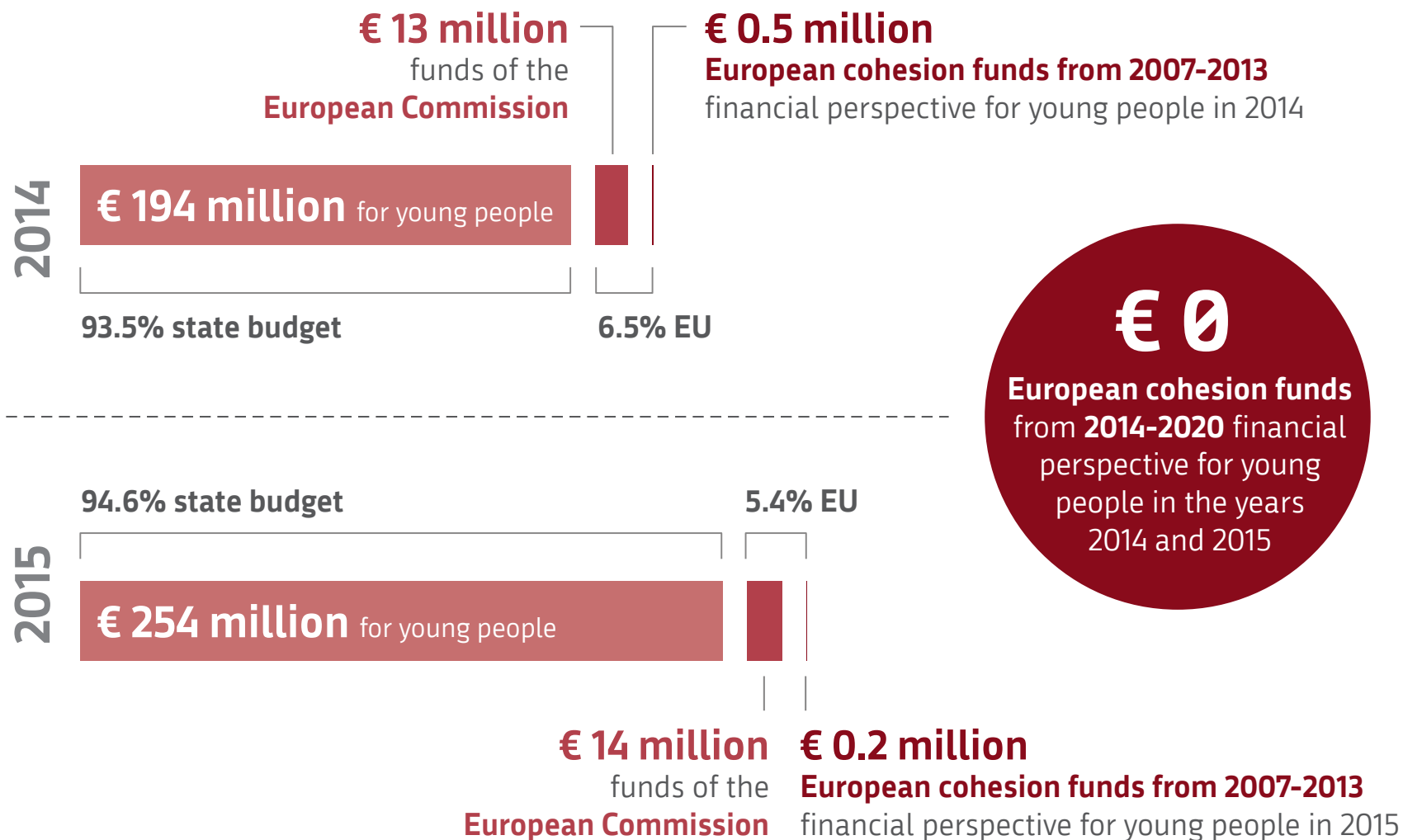
In the period 2005-2015,

Planning **not based on relevant analyses**, the activities thus not focused on all main problem areas



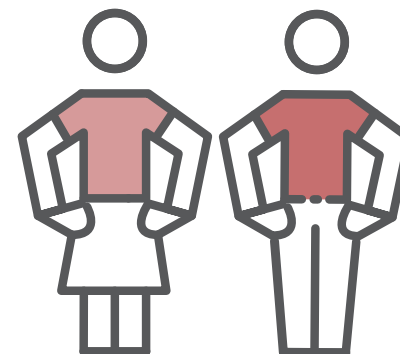
Financing and timeliness of implementing measures **not in line with the needs of young people**



Many measures **without clear long-term benefits** to address problems of young people

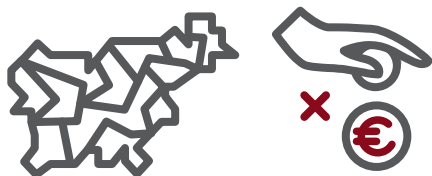


The Government and the Ministry of Education, Science and Sport **failed to appropriately provide all available sources of funding**, e.g. EU funds

**Financing** of activities at local level **not legally regulated**

In **2014** and **2015**, an **efficient system** for monitoring the implementation of measures and projects within the framework of youth policy **was not established**.
