



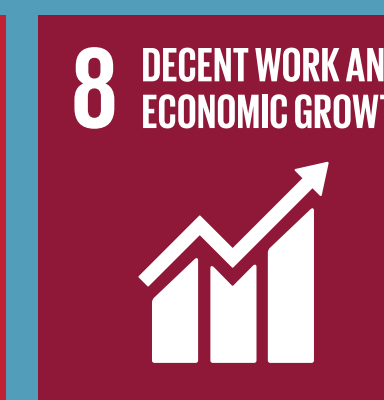

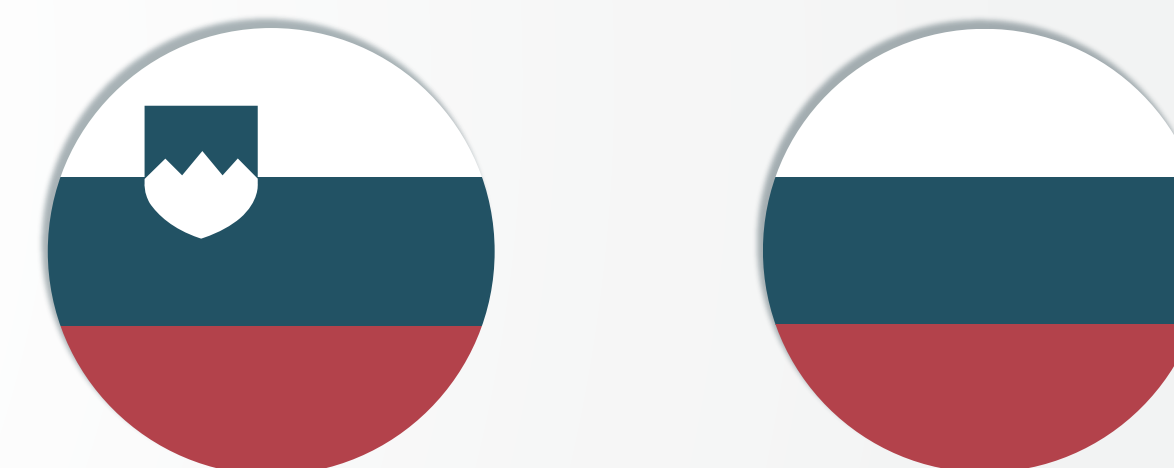
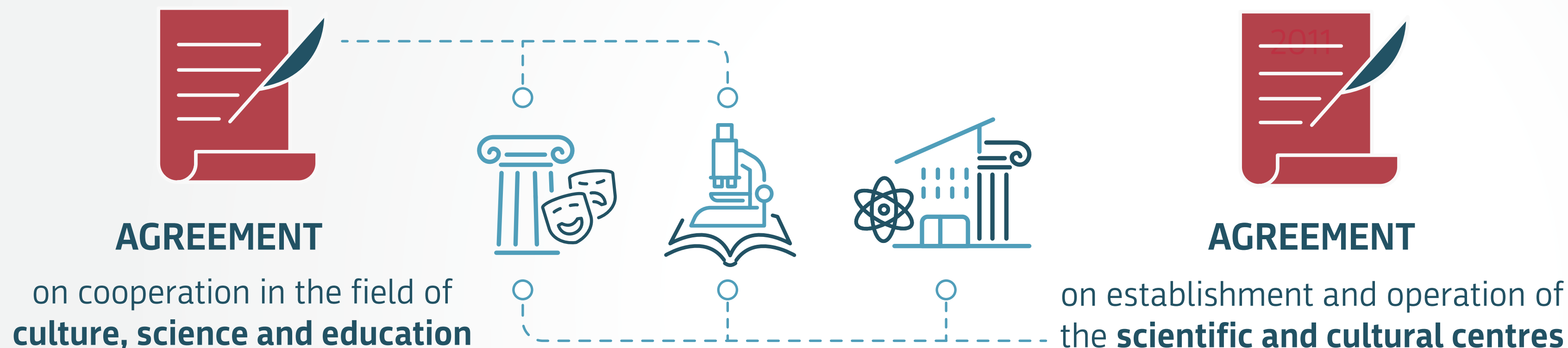


Cooperation is carried out on the basis of two agreements

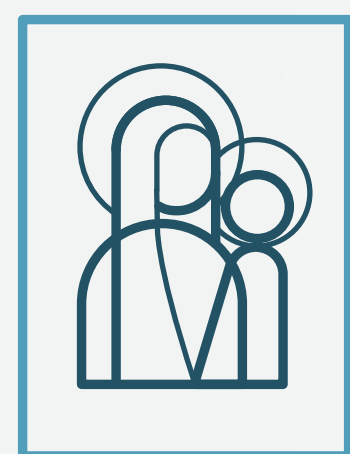

Most of the objectives defined in the intergovernmental programmes **were achieved**



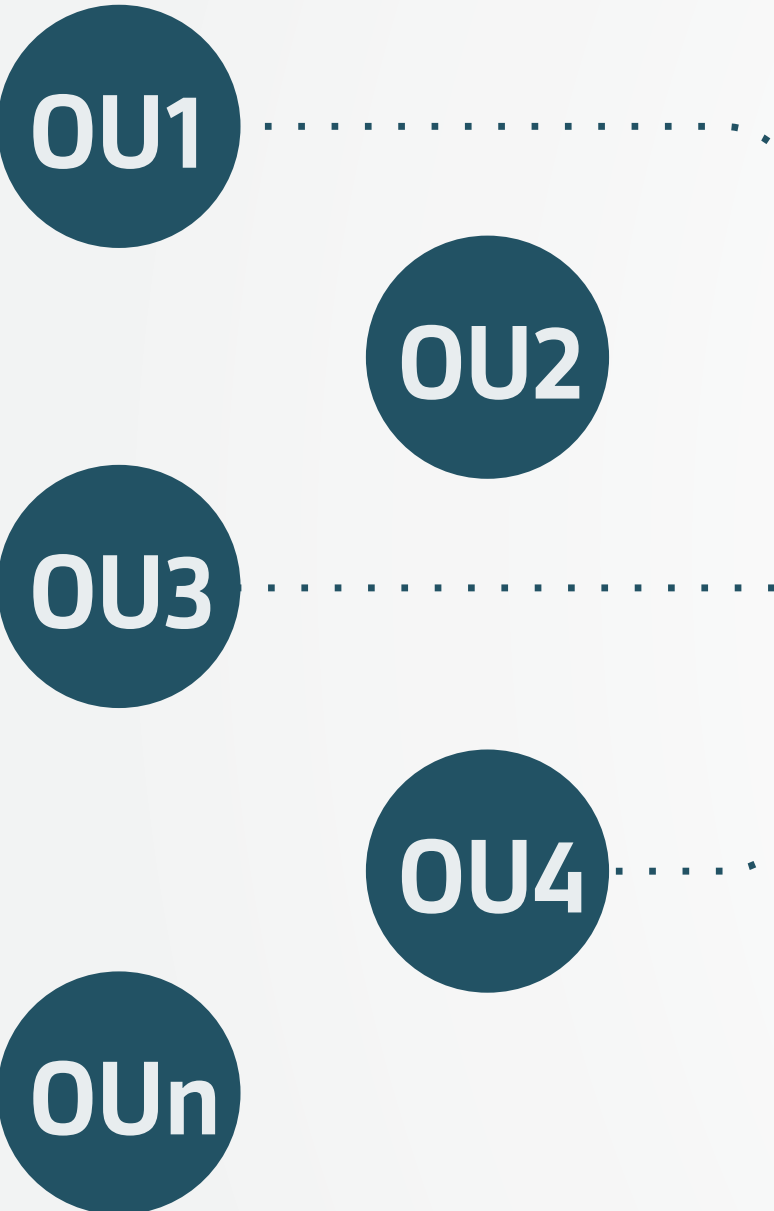
Some objectives, mainly those linked to the **cooperation among entities** of both countries, **were not met**.



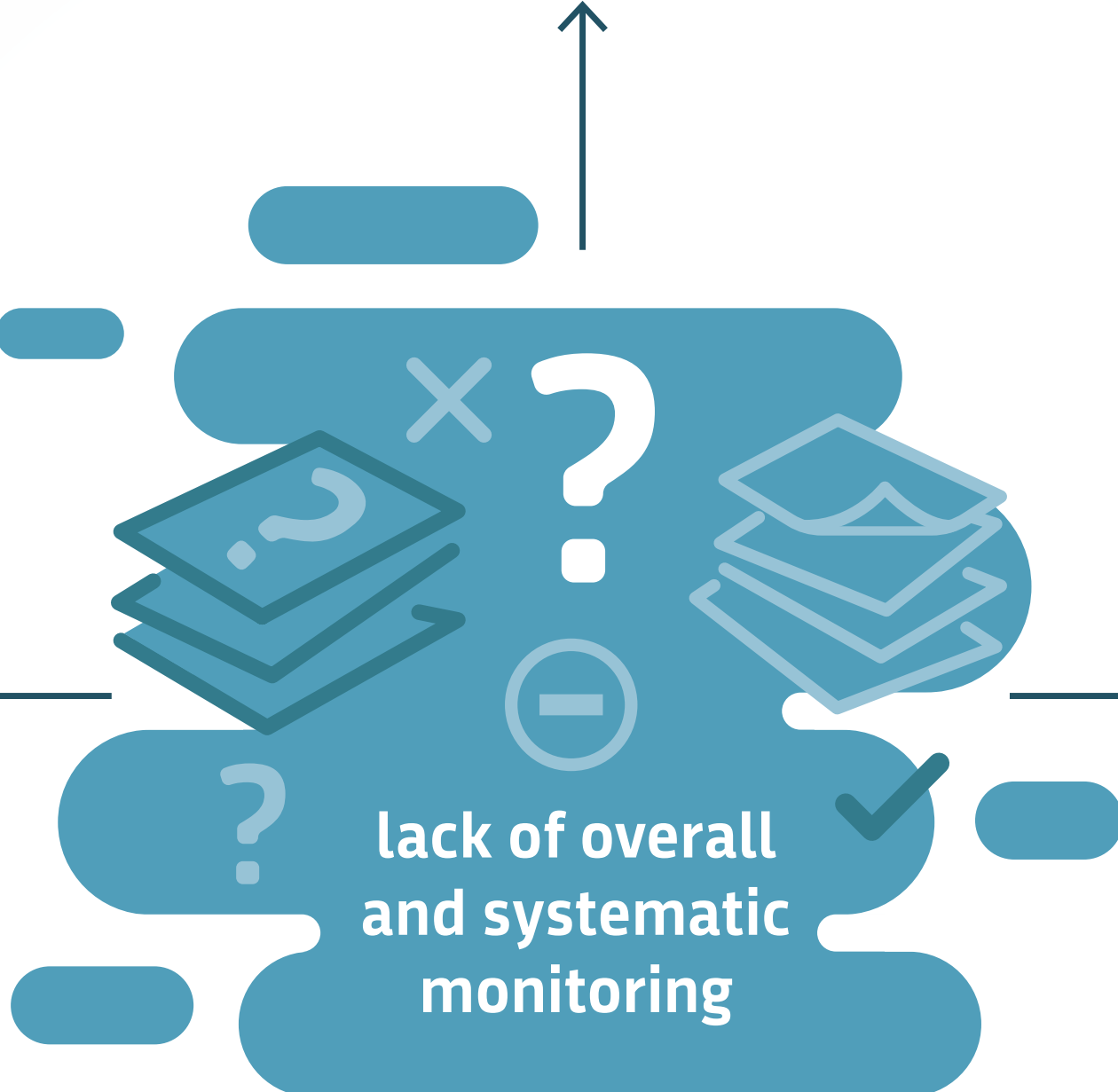

Monitoring of the cooperation

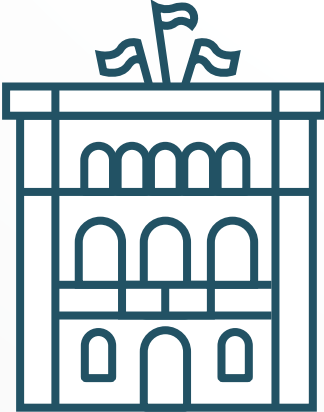
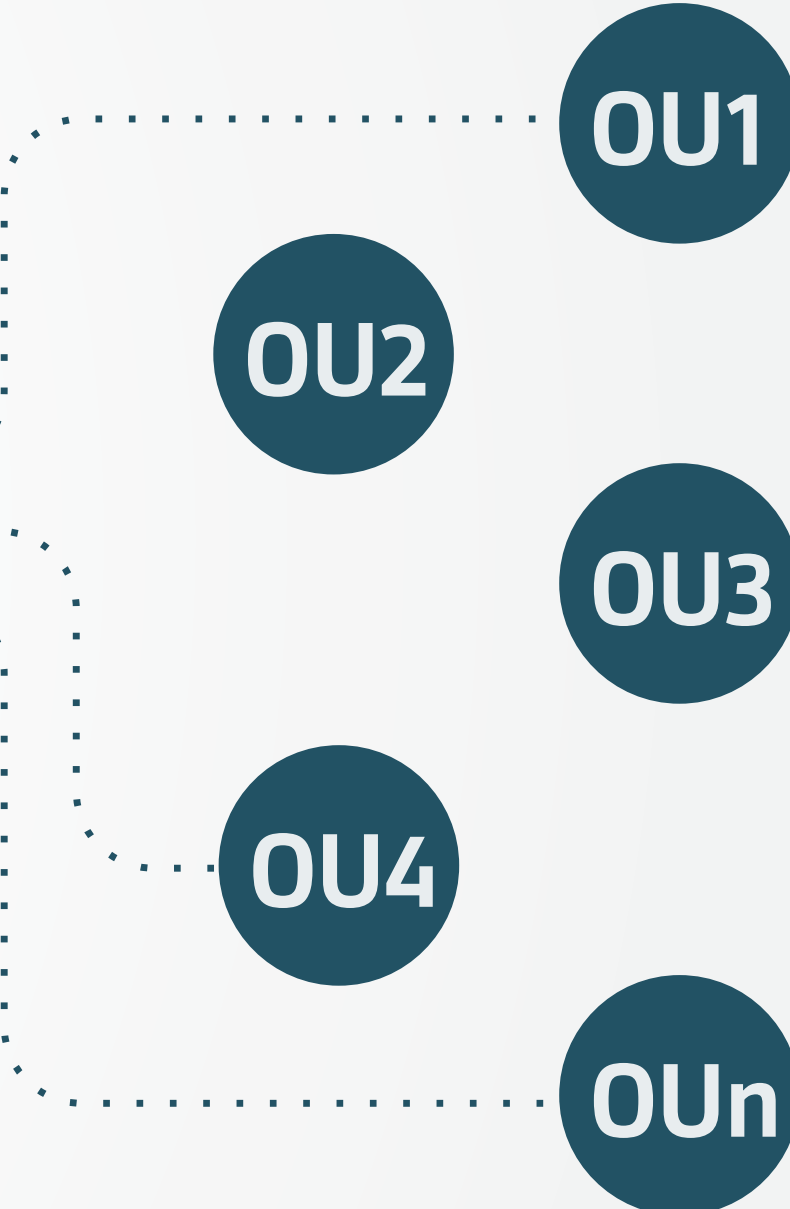
Cooperation is monitored by organisational units

OPINION OF THE COURT OF AUDIT

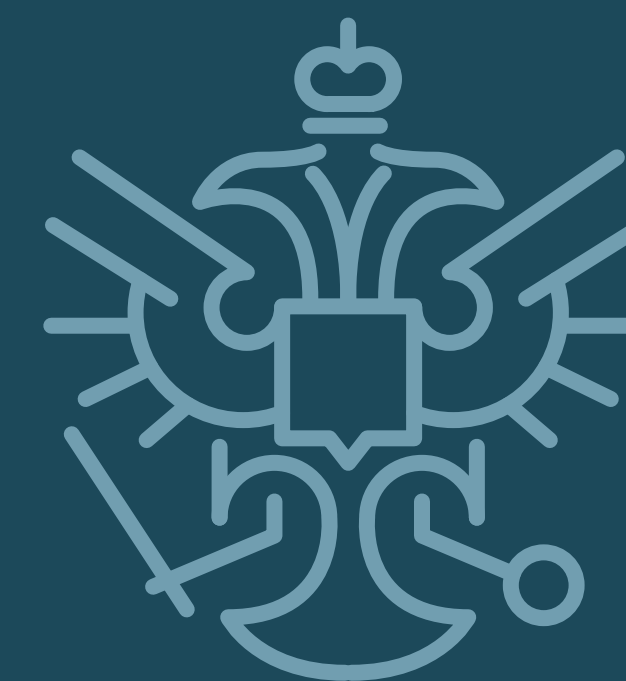
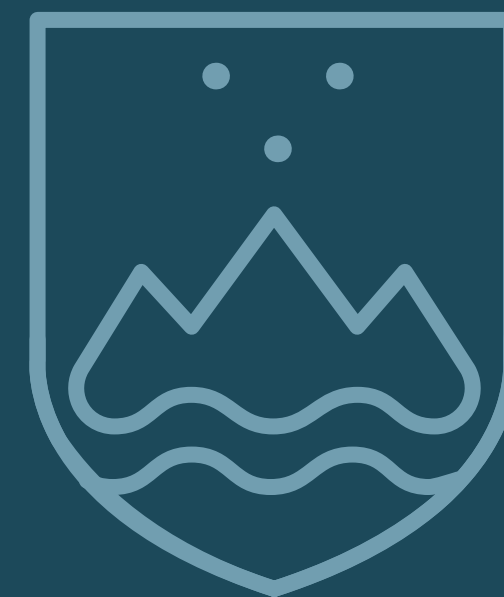


Auditees were **effective enough** in achieving the objectives set in both agreements and in implementing the activities
