



OPINION OF THE COURT OF AUDIT



Ljubljana Pharmacy was efficient in managing business continuity.



The Court of Audit did not demand the submission of a response report from Ljubljana Pharmacy, but proposed several recommendations. Ljubljana Pharmacy implemented some recommendations already during the audit, among others:



it made steps towards Business Continuity Policy by including all detected risks



it informed the users about the Information System Business Continuity Plan
