

AUDIT REPORT Housing policy implementation in the Republic of Slovenia

Performance audit

Audit period: 1 January 2015 to 30 June 2021







Single older women (65+)

– a high poverty risk group, reside on approx.

68 m² of living area.

Young people between 20 and 30 reside on approx. **24 m² of living area.**

In 2020, **40.8%** of young people in the age group 25 to 34 lived with their parents.

According to the Statistical Office of the Republic of Slovenia, **20%** of all dwellings were empty in 2018.




Can the State ensure 33,000 public rental housing?

How were the measures set out in the Resolution implemented?



Resolution on the National Housing Programme 2015–2025 addresses relevant existing problems



but does not foresee programming of financial resources.





- the number of public rental housing units not known
- the number of empty dwellings not known
- a record on illegal construction not kept

REGULARISATION

- no new housing act, covering all planned measures set out in the Resolution
- reform of land and spatial policy not prepared



DEFINING THE TERM 'PUBLIC RENTAL HOUSING'

 What is included under public rental housing?



ESTABLISHING THE HOUSING POLICY COUNCIL

 the Government failed to establish a main body responsible for coordinating the housing policy objectives



ESTABLISHING RENTAL PROPERTY MANAGEMENT PUBLIC SERVICE

 should provide for the activation of 2,000 empty dwellings, but was established only in 2022





COST RENT AND HOUSING BENEFIT

 the Ministry and the Government failed to draw up systemic solutions, they only corrected the upper amount of non-profit rents, therefore the housing funds increase the scope of market-rate rental housing



ENERGY RENOVATION OF HOUSING

 measures that would promote comprehensive energy renovation of housing developments were not implemented





ANALYSIS

 poor reporting to the Government, which did not enable taking appropriate actions

ACTION PLAN FOR FUTURE ACTIVITIES was not adopted.

OPINION OF THE COURT OF AUDIT



Implementation of housing policy in the period from 1 January 2015 to 30 June 2021 was inefficient.

The Court of Audit proposed to the Government and the Ministry several recommendations, among others:

The GOVERNMENT should

- establish the Housing Policy
 Council
- make a decision about imposing a real estate tax and introducing a systemic source for financing housing policy projects

The MINISTRY should

- examine the possibility of establishing a record of empty dwellings, a record of illegal construction and a complete record of renting operations
- make a decision about
 a document of priority
 development areas for the
 purpose of housing supply



DEMAND

the **GOVERNMENT** and the **MINISTRY** must participate in the process of drawing up new **Spatial Planning Strategy of Slovenia**



the **MINISTRY** must **adopt plans of activities** for:

- establishing the record of public rental housing
- reform of housing legislation
- drawing up an action plan for the implementation of projects foreseen in the Resolution after 2023

 unify terminology pertaining to (rental) housing

- impose cost rent and housing benefit
- thoroughly monitor housing policy implementation

The state shall create opportunities for citizens to obtain proper housing.
