



How did Agency technically establish data transmission?



Agency demanded from data transmission providers to develop and integrate into their own information environment a programming interface (API) for retrieving data from them

- Agency failed to efficiently support data providers in meeting its demands
- Agency **failed to examine other approaches,** such as central programming interface or on-line form, although the majority of data providers submitted data for only one off-taker
- Agency failed to follow the principles of information security
 - it collected **data** for accessing information environment of data providers at the **joint e-mail address** and submitted the data also to the **private e-mail address** outside of the Agency's mail server
 - Agency required from data providers to keep connections open and did not inform them for several months they can close them after the last retrieval of data




How did Agency organise data transmission?



How did Agency estimate the cost of data transmission?

The cost of development of each API was estimated at about € 1,000.

- the estimation was **not based on expert analysis**
- the estimation did not consider the cost of setting up a safe dedicated server
- the Agency did not examine whether the required form of reporting was appropriate for 440 data providers who reported for 5 or less off-takers



What timeline did Agency set for data collection?

Agency obtained the data on who data transmission providers are on 28 February 2023.

- only 133 days later, the Agency passed this information on to data providers; majority of them did not know that off-takers applied for aid in line with ZPGOPEK
- 40 days after the notice by the Agency, data providers were obliged to have a running API

OPINION OF THE COURT OF AUDIT



The Court of Audit proposed to the Agency **several recommendations.**
