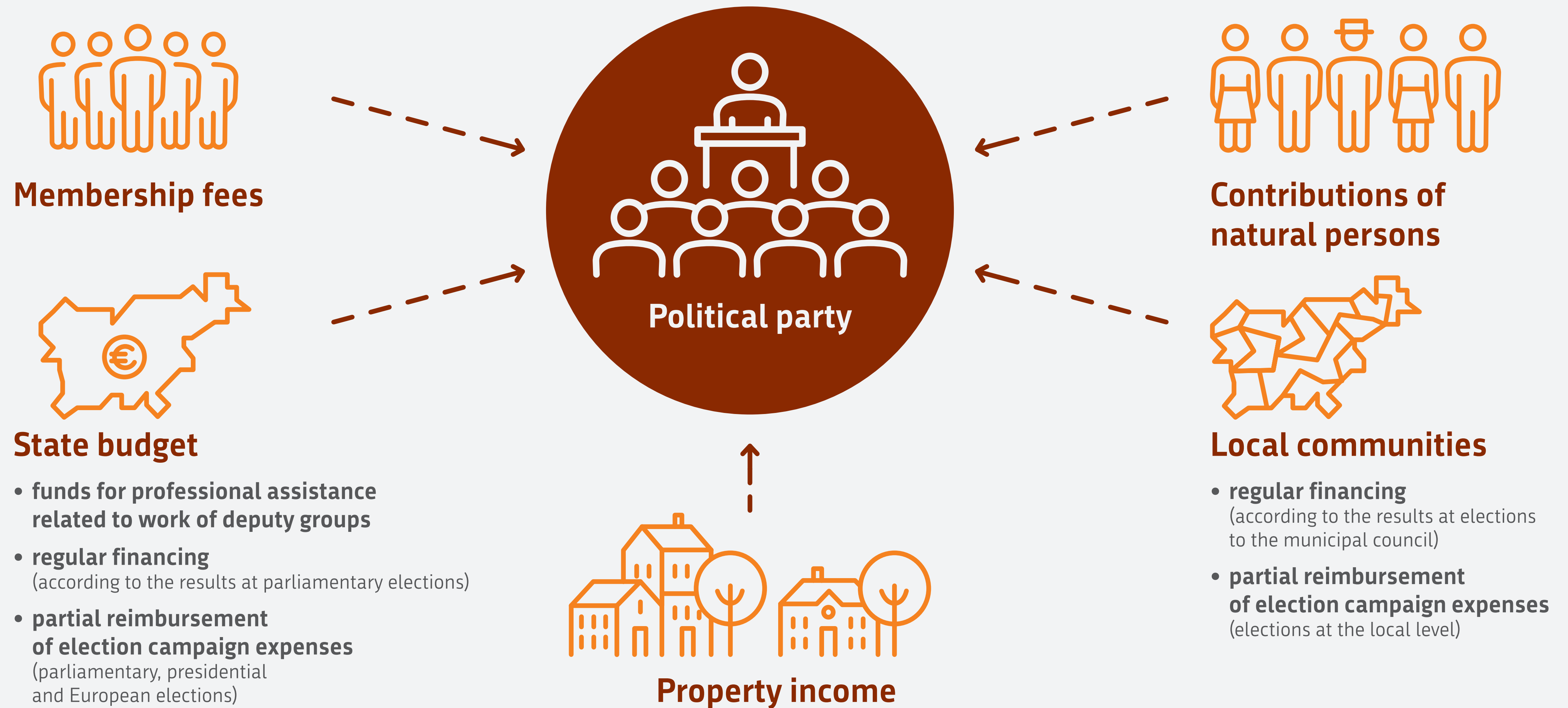

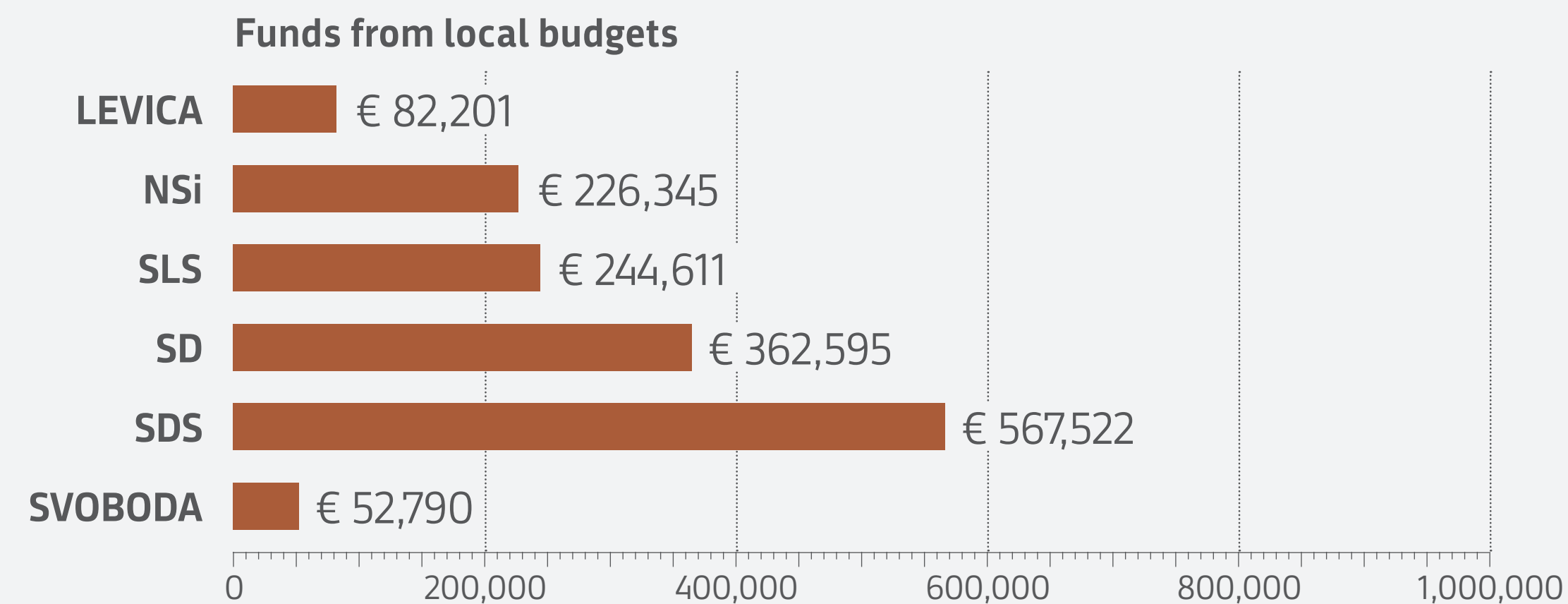

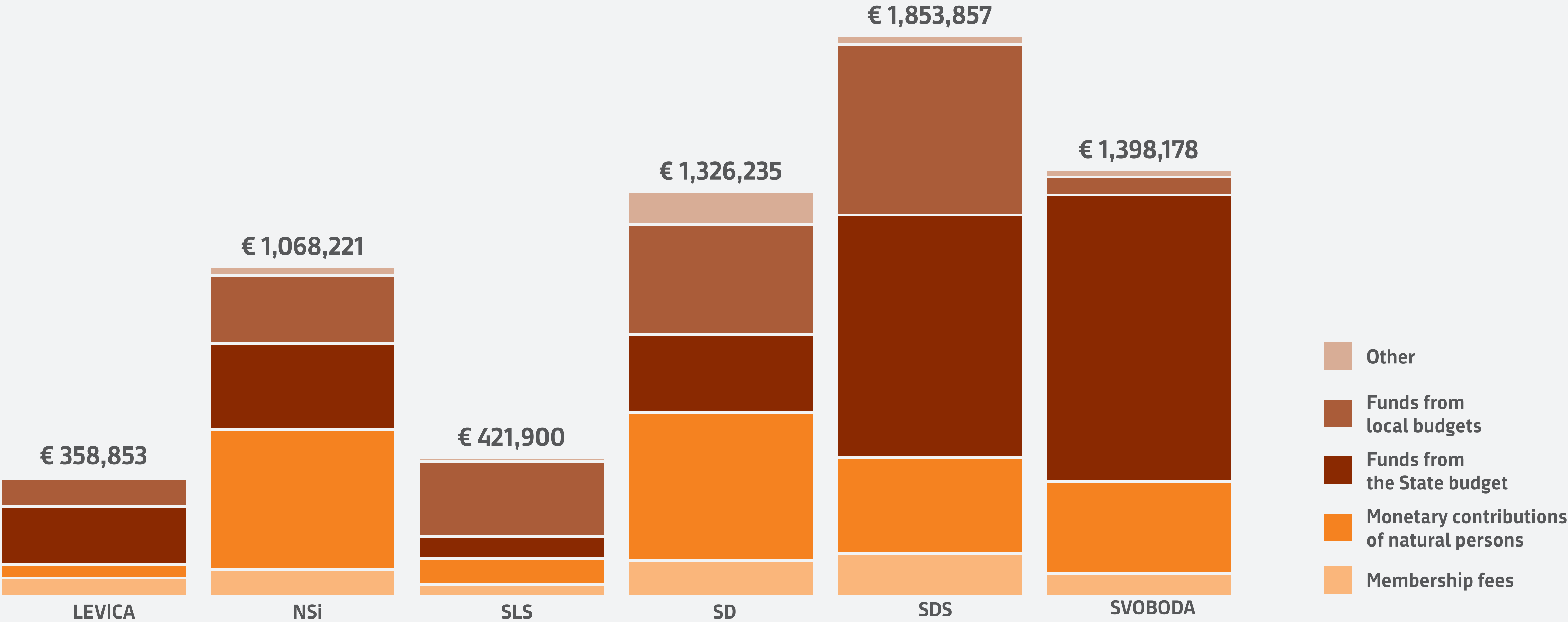
Operations of political parties in 2022 – revenue

Revenue by sources, comparison between the parties



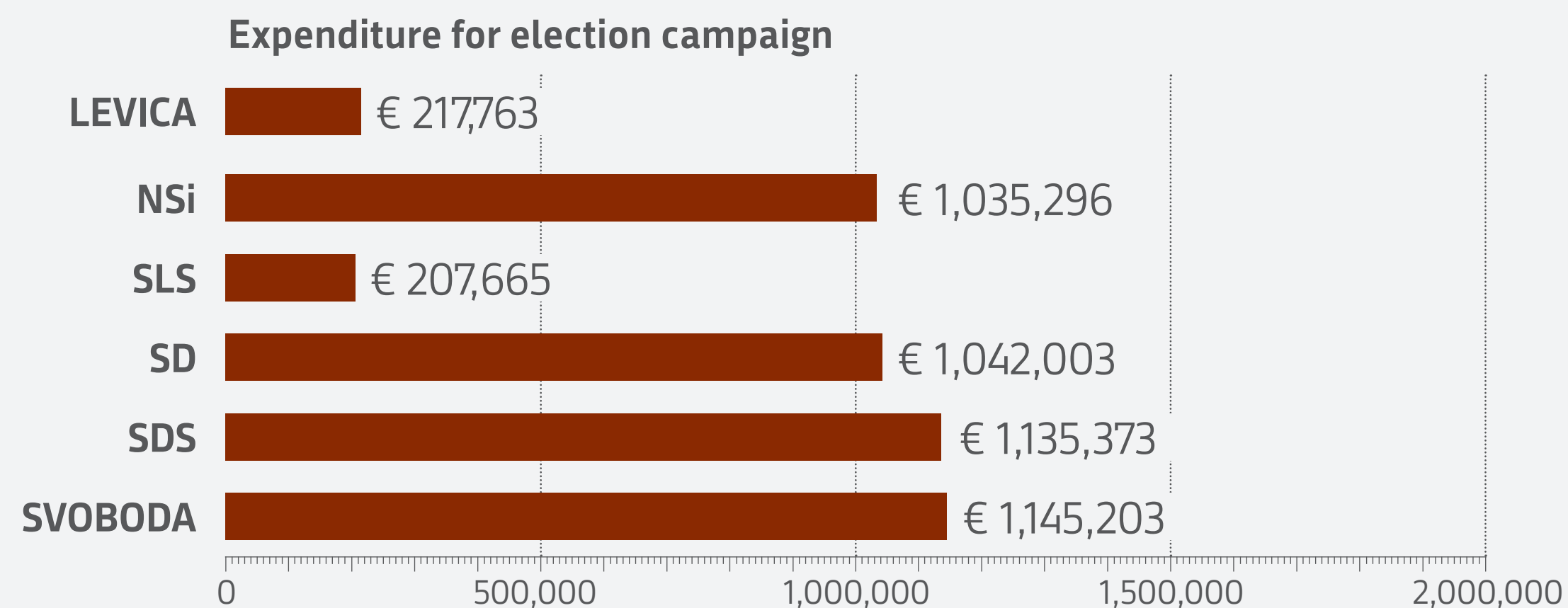
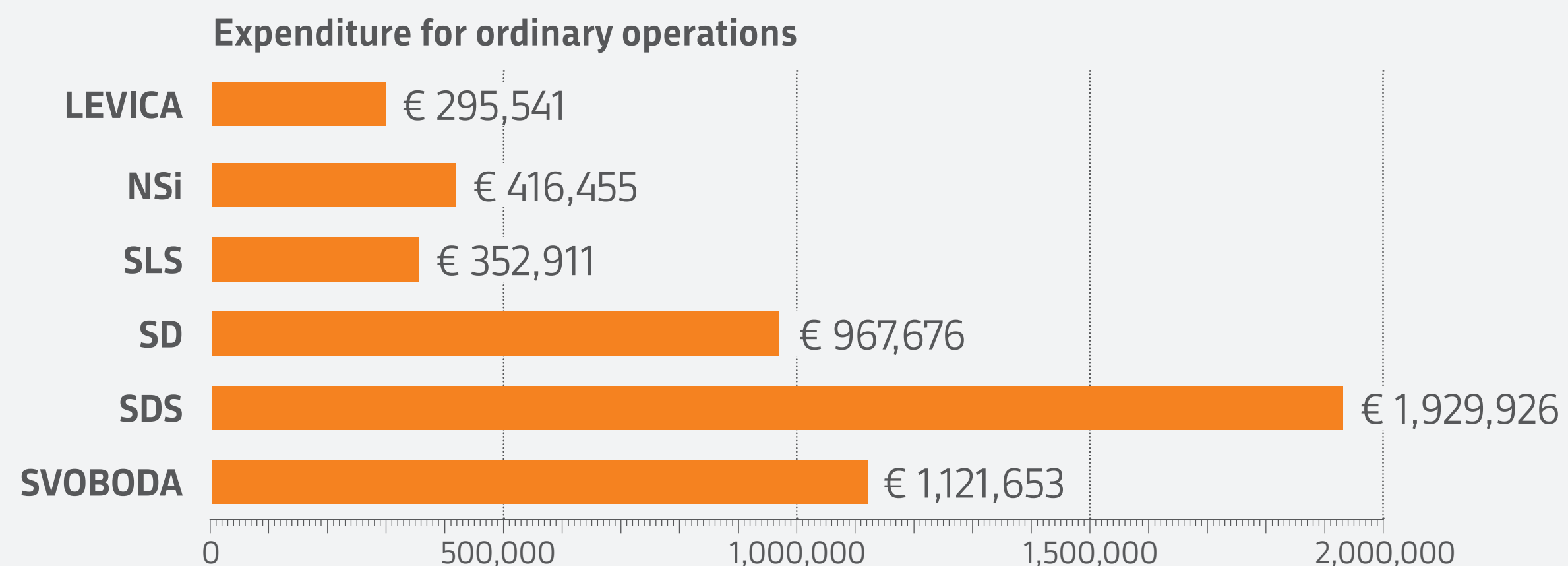

Political party's sources of revenue

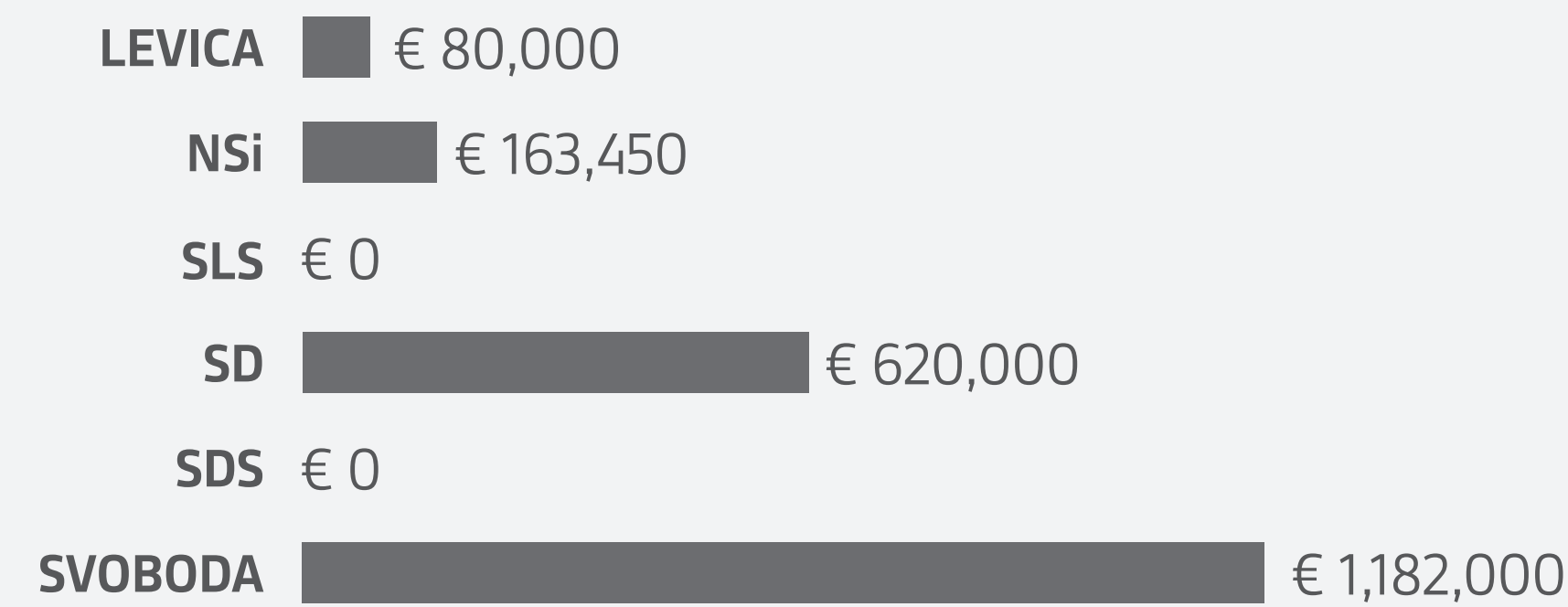


Operations of political parties in 2022 – expenditure and loans
