

Providing and financing of universal postal service (UPS)







decrease in lettermail from 2011 to 2021 by 30.7%



reduction in the number of postal outlets from 2017 to 2021 by 15%



disagreements about entitlement to compensation for implementing UPS

SHORTCOMINGS IN REGULATIONS



not clear, which services must be carried out as UPS, thereby affecting:

- price and quality of services
- presentation in separate accounting records
- calculation of compensation for implementing UPS

limited powers (consent only)



specific set of services depends on the proposals by the Post of Slovenia







Prices of UPS did not cover all UPS costs






does not have competence for **proposing** price changes (consent only)

proposals to raise prices of UPS were insufficiently substantiated by the Post of Slovenia


Does the system of financing UPS ensure long-term fiscal sustainability?

methodology for the calculation of compensation not clearly defined

the relevant act and other general acts by AKOS do not sufficiently define the procedure and elements for calculating the compensation

large differences between calculations by AKOS and by the Post of Slovenia (several million €)









payment mechanism does not ensure compensation for disadvantage arising from the obligation to provide UPS

compensation provided fund

not established


UPS provider should pay the largest share


The system of providing and financing of universal postal service was **partially efficient.**







Ministry of the Economy, Tourism and Sport must:






develop a plan of activities for drawing up a proposal for amending Postal Services Act
