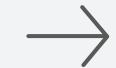

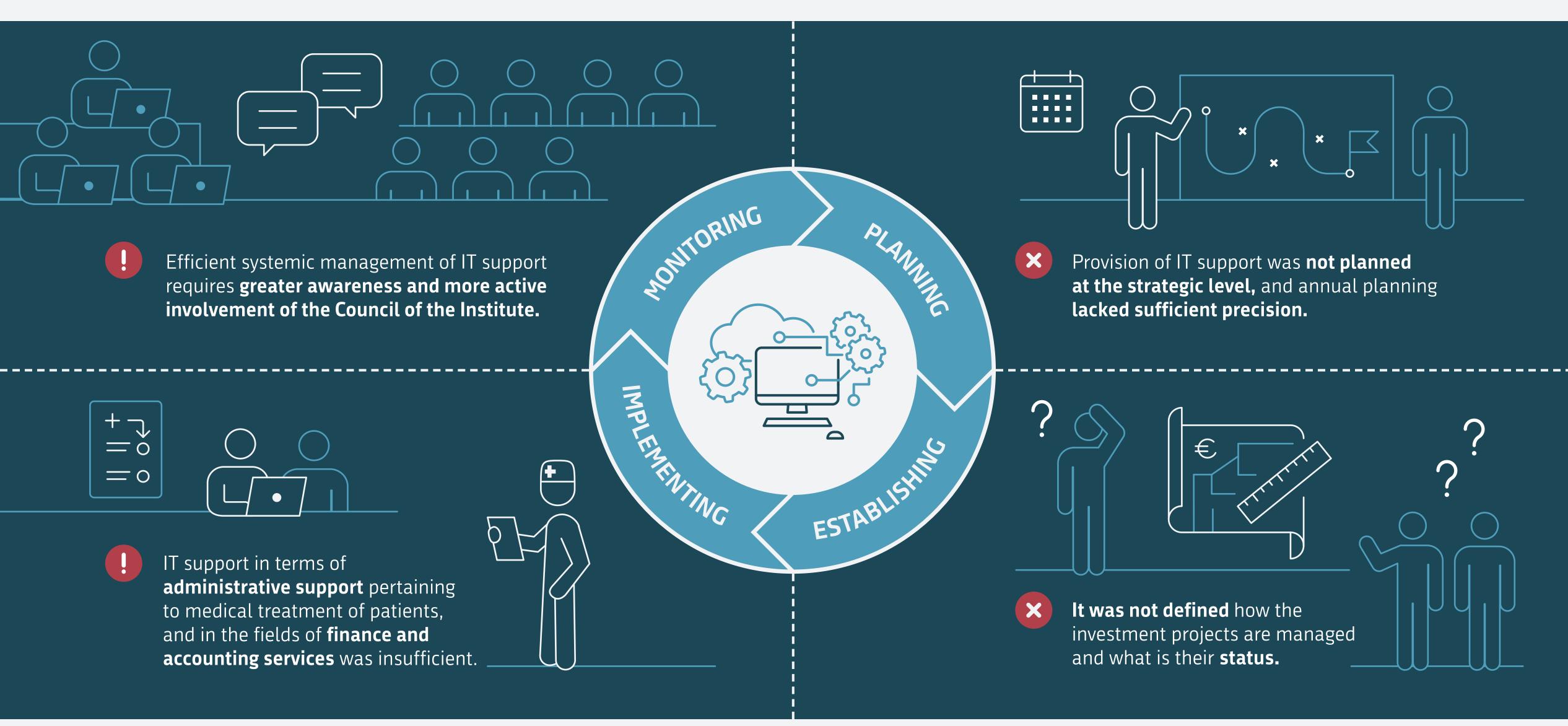

Deficiencies in the provision of IT support



Nevertheless, several organisational processes were efficiently supported through IT





IT support of healthcare services, human resources management and services reimbursement from ZZZS (Health Insurance Institute of Slovenia) was overall efficiently provided.



Outsourcing agreements adequately protected financial and legal interests of the Institute.



Education and training on the use of new IT solutions and data protection was organised for the employees.



An adequate level of data protection was ensured in relationships with external providers of IT support.



The users of IT solutions were provided thereto related support.



Reporting to the Council of the Institute about activities in the field of IT support was improving.

As regards systemic management of IT support, the Court of Audit recommended to the Institute of Oncology Ljubljana among others:



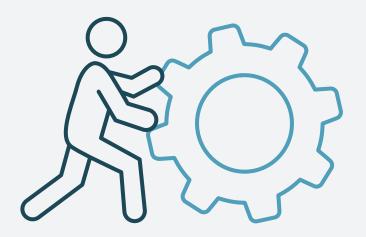
to sustain through strategic planning a long-term efficient system of providing IT support
